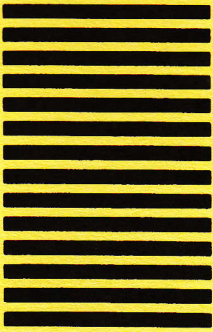

How To Validate Your Warranty

To validate your warranty, fill out the attached warranty card and return it to ENSONIQ within ten days of the purchase date.

What Is Covered And What Is Not Covered?

This warranty covers all defects in material and workmanship for twelve months from the date of original purchase. This warranty does not cover damage to or deterioration of the external cabinet, the keyboard and internal circuitry resulting from accident, misuse, neglect, attempted unauthorized repair or failure to follow instructions in the owner's manual.

This warranty does not cover units that have been modified or altered. (The only exception is an Authorized ENSONIQ modification which includes its own warranty coverage.)

This warranty does not cover damage that may occur during shipping.

Software/Firmware are sold as is and are not covered by warranty. ENSONIQ accessory items are covered under a separate limited warranty.

How To Obtain Warranty Performance

Return your unit to an Authorized ENSONIQ Repair Station. If you are unable to locate one, write or call the ENSONIQ Factory Service Department. We will either refer you to an Authorized Repair Station or issue you a return authorization number for factory service. Units returned to ENSONIQ for factory service must prominently display the return authorization number on the outside of the shipping carton and on all related documents or units will be returned freight collect. You must pay all shipping costs to and from the factory.

Shipment of the product to ENSONIQ is the responsibility of the owner, and should be insured by the owner for the full value of the product.
