Kids these days . . .), the external hardware delay compensation, and so on. Also, a nice librarian for audio, video, and MIDI files. None of these individually would make it worth the jump for me (I can manage presets, thank you very much), but put together it looks like a real winner. I _think_ it's a big enough deal that I'll switch when it comes time to mix the Monkies. I'll keep tracking in 3.x because that's working fine but I might take the plunge for 4.x.

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Supposedly they've improved.
