> with steel wool (not by me) and is abraided a bit, but this isn't a super
> flaw. The cabinet has some buzzes that are apparent when the amp is
> cranked (what old amp doesn't). It could use some tightening up or
> crosssbracing to eliminate these. I have also had the original power cord
> replaced and an XLR plug installed to connect the head to the cab and the
> ground switch on the front of the amp has been disconnected.

> The amp tracks very well. I spent about a month just cleaning the grime
> and smell off of it when I got it. The Tolex is in surprisingly good
> shape, preserved through the years under a disgusting crust of nicotine
> and grime. Smelled like it had lived in the bathroom of a biker bar for
> the last 40 years when I first got it. The first picture (named Ampeg
> B-15) was taken right after it arrived.
