I always used external verbs, too. I doubt I will again. I was digging through the esp code I've got, and I don't have an exact match for the expert verb in the DP/Pro, at least not according to the DP/Pro manual's parameter list. But, the collection clearly looks like a compilable project for the DP/Pro effects. It's a puzzle.

There is one reverb with 7 early reflection, and the DP/Pro manual mentions 8 for the expert verb. That's the closest match I can find.

Anyway, there are several reverbs, another hall, a room, a small room, and several plates. There's actually more here that I thought, which is great! I also want to do the stereo pitch shifter.

I'm hoping to have the vocal plate out before the end of April.
