I was on holiday until a moment ago. PARIS doesn't have the ability to use Rewire, either as a host or a slave - it was discontinued around the time ReWire was invented.

I use three ADAT cards and ADAT sync to an RME 9652 card in the same computer to achieve similar results with PARIS/Reaper (sample accurate sync/transport coordination/24 tracks).

Yes, it's easy, but the way I do it (listed in the other thread) requires two extra pieces of hardware: at least one ADAT card in your MEC, and a sound card with a 9-pin ADAT sync connector. That will give you sample accurate sync and as many channels of transfer as you have the MECs/ADAT cards/audio cards to support. I have three ADAT cards flowing into one RME card - hence 24 tracks, split over two MECs.
