Hello Dimitrios!

I bought my Paris v3 as a standalone and it is still in it's original CD jewel box case.
A simple white sticker on the case reads:

E-MU Paris Pro Key Number
XX-XXXX-XXXX
Keep this number for future installation
Paris authorization!

The license is written into the EULA. The above X's are all numbers, but yours appears to have ten alpha numeric key as well.

> EMU PN CDxxxxx does this mean anything at all ?

That is printed onto the CD itself and is only a Part Number.

From your description you look okay but the proof is when ID approves with a response code. Other than that, there was no fancy license sticker like what you might find on a MS product.
