I have SATA on my PARIS comp and it seems fine; haven't torture tested it yet though. Common sense would say it would be great, but actual usage doesn't always bear out common sense, so I'm wondering the same thing.

As far as word clock, that's new ground for me with PARIS. You clock the MECs rather than the

EDS, so it goes by numbers of MECs you have - I believe with three or more, you need an external word clock and with less than three you don't.
