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Hey guys - been lurking for a long time, haven't posted in years. But I've just started working heavily with my Paris rig again, and though I've scoured the depths of the newsgroup and been through my manual cover to cover, there's one thing I can't seem to do. So I turn to you, oh wise and helpful compadres!

How do I move (or delete) a whole track in freeform mode? I had to insert some audio tracks to import all my audio, and my MIDI track got stuck as track 34 or some such. Now I want to make it track 23, and I can't seem to find any way to move or delete the track itself (not just the objects). I can certainly add another MIDI track at #23, but then I'd have this orphan MIDI track hanging out in the middle of nowhere. Granted this does nothing more than affront my slightly OCD sensibilities, but I have a hard time believing that Paris doesn't have a track move/delete function. Am I missing it?

On a side note, has anyone thought to make a package of the original Paris skin? I downloaded the new skins from the parisfaqs site, but I didn't see the original skin. I'm working on the whole skinning for the Mac bit, and I need a copy of the original BMP for comparison. If anybody has them handy, could you send them along?
