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Neil, I have Voxformer but I am having "dropouts" on vocals in PARIS. I have tried disabling most all of the stuff in the plug, i.e., compressors, gate, presence, etc., turning down input gain, but still the same thing and not always in the same place. It sounds like they're being gated off at random times, may'be twice during the song for a real short period. Tried it on an instrument on another channel with same result. Any ideas?
