I would first check out that ME hasn't automagically changed some IRQ assignments for you on it's own causing a conflict with video. It does that. Next, I would get a good nVidia video card and drop into the AGP slot. Be careful when you install the new card because it might try to install a newer DirectX version that could hose up your DX effects.

Also, get yourself a Power Leap CPU upgrade. I put one on my Asus P2B-LS (and before that the P2B-f) mobo and it's a WAY different machine. Hopefully they still have it, it's a celeron 1.3Ghz on a slot style mini PCB.
