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It can be a good idea to try a reinstall.

If so, make a backup of the Paris map as a zip or RAR file a place on the harddisk or burn a CD with it, just to have copies of "Paris_fx.var" and "Paris.cfg". Uninstall Paris and delete the E-mu\Paris pro maps before a clean reinstall. If it's a WinXP installation, be sure to follow the XP-prosedyre and also have a look at Mike Audet's updates for modern WinXP computers.
