Then when I try to import the = ripped music into Paris I get an error. Then if you look in my record = director there will be 2 .paf files (even if I set it to default to = ...wav). If I try to import these into Paris you can hear the files but = Paris thinks they are 30 minutes long each. This would not be that big = of a deal but I want it working right.
