If you feel like being a guinea pig, you could try adding /INTAFFINITY to

your boot.ini file rather than disabling hyperthreading.

The boot.ini file lives at c:\boot.ini. You may have to enable "show hidden files and folder" and/or turn off "hide protected operating system files" to see it by going to "tools - folderoptions - view" and making the changes.

Here's the contents of my boot.ini for reference:
