I'm waiting on a power amp to show up from my NS10M's. I tried a number of amps that I had access to in this area and the one I like best wasn't one of the Yamaha amps. It was, surprisingly (I guess) an Alesis Matica 900.....very open, clean and detailed sounding with 270WPC.....so anyway, I found one and that's what's going to show up here next week to power these things. Maybe I'll change my mind, but that one seemed the best sounding of the bunch to my ears. In the meantime I want to use them so I hooked them up to a consumer grade Sony amp that is very clean and rated 230W / impedance use 6-16 ohms. That's pretty broad and the NS10M's are 8ohm IIRC, so I oughta' be goo if I don't try to drive these puppies too hard.....right?
