I'm sorry for the lack of specifics, I was re-posting from another post that had all my info.

Anyway here is the situation:

I have an HP with a dual core AMD X2 proc. It has 2gig of ram and is running XP home.

I disabled the onboard video card and I am running a PCI-E card.

There are no PCI conflicts.

installed the proper xp drivers and subsystem in the correct folder.

I copied the Paris pro folder onto the C: drive and ran it from there, but that seemed to make it crash more.

I can open and run Paris, and close usually without errors. If I try to run Paris a second time, it will crash, and then if I try to run it again it sometimes works.

I have had some fatal exceptions while working on a project, not that I never had that before, but it seems to be happening much more often.

I noticed that I can't save presets for native plugins, also.

Do you have any ideas?
