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Ivory may be able to use it but I would be curious what your actual RAM usage is when running Ivory, and if you are using the /3G switch to access above 2G, or if it just stabilizes Win/Cubase when using over 1.2G.

WinXP limits apps to 1.2G. With 2G, supposedly the /3G switch also bumps the 2G usage to 1.7G for apps, and of course is supposed to open up 3G usage. Nuendo has issues above 1.2G that cause instability, corrupt projects, etc, though there is an error handler in Nuendo now (I assume Cubase too) that usually allows you to save your project to a new file if it detects this problem. It is an annoyance, and can be problematic with large sample libraries (orchestral here, using NI's DSD, so it may not be as much of an issue with piano libraries - single instrument, different streaming technique, etc).
