So if you wanna put a vst reverb like new Lexicon vst reverb algorithms without using the senderella trick here is an easy alternative...

- 1) First you have to have Chainer wrapper...
- 2) You have to use two tracks on your eds submix.
- 3) Copy your vocal track from track 1 to track 2 (same wavefile)
- 4) Use the stereo (x) on your paris vst section before opening Chainer at vst insert on track 1. Thus you will have a stereo instance of chainer applied on tracks 1&2 aka your vocal track.
- 5) Open vst reverb plugin
- 6) Now use the wet/dry option in chainer to introduce the dry vocal sound as much as needed

That is it !!
