I use the s/pdif. I'm REALLY digging the multi band compression. I was SO impressed at how quickly it glued my tracks together. PLUS, I got it on ebay for under \$250! Very happy! It also has adat i/o and the d/a conversion sounds good. Got it all clocked up to the old Rosetta, although it doesn't have word clock, but it will clock to s/pdif OR adat.
