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Guys, I've got some major problems and could use some serious advice.

System

Win98se
512 Ram
Asus 8n8x motherboard
Asus 9600se dual head video PCI card
OS drive
Audio drive
Paris 3.0 3 card system

I recently added a Magma Chassis. Successfully moved all three cards to chassis without incident. Paris works without flaw.

I then added a new Memorex CD/DVD burner. System looked good until I attempted the first CD burn. Though the cd burned, I crashed and received the following error:

0028:c004d8c5 in vxd vfat(01) + 0000b8ed 0028:c1c2f4c0 in VXD voltrack(04) + 00000430

I removed the connection to the MEC and Magma chassis to no avail. I googled it, but could not make head nor tales of the problem, so after several hours, I removed the Memorex drive, then reinstalled the original CD writer. Though I did not receive the "voltrack" error anymore, I could only read the "Nero" software installation cd. When I attempt to read ANY other cd the system locks up.

I entered "Safe mode" to see if I could find resolution there, then I received:

"There is a problem with your display settings. The adaptor type is incorrect or the current settings do not work with your hardware."

At this point, the system no longer goes into "Safe mode", nor shows the IRQ screen....it simply freezes until I do a 'hard" reset. I can force my way into "Safe mode" at boot up, but it does not show any specific details regarding my Asus adaptor, only the generic monitor settings.
