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Jeff.....perhaps that is the reason for the *USB over current* message. Maybe this dongle triggers some kind of evil spirit in the 1017 bios in these mobo's. The secret is to use an earlier BIOS that does not display this message. I think it's a bug in the BIOS, not the dongle. I've got everything here on voltage regulators and I doubt it's an issue with my peripheral hardware.

Anyway, I'm using BIOS v1014 and this thing is rocking right along now. It feels very stable so far, but I haven't really put it under any stress yet. That will come later today.
