I don't use them. v3 VST doesn't work with Nuendo 3 and I didn't want to pay for the WUP plan just to get a compatible version. I also moved away from using them a few years ago - not the sound I wanted - a bit veiled - esp. the Ren series. They do work and are good plugins but not what I go to on a daily basis - I have other goto choices for every plugin in the bundle. Just no point in letting them sit there when someone else might use them more, and/or would want to use them to upgrade to v5 or Platinum.

I had considered keeping them and upgrading, but I just can't justify it for what I am doing and how little I would use them.
