The only exchange we ever had from AM II was to AM III with Pro Tools software with DAE powermix back in 1996 for \$995, both products have long since been discontinued. Since then there have been multiple exchanges with multiple options so there is no telling what direction you might have gone. Ultimately you probably would have spent more in the long run upgrading along the way but you would have recouped much if not all of the value of your purchase in using your system as the Technology progressed over the past 14 years.
