I first put the EDS card in the computer. Next, I downloaded and installed the XP drivers version 3.03. I rebooted the computer when prompted. I then downloaded and installed the Paris application (version 2.20) from the EMU site. I rebooted the computer. I then installed the Paris XP Effects Subsystem and rebooted. When I try to run Paris.exe, I get the "Paris.exe is not a valid Win32 application" error message.

I would deeply appreciate any help/comments/suggestions on this.
