Update: Thank you all for your donations. I've gone back to UPS, FDX and US postal service for shipping prices and due to Covid they're worse. FDX \$346.50, USPS \$404.65, and UPS 424.60. Also, I've found it may take up to 30 days to go through customs which is not a real issue but Mike may have to pay tax on the value of the items. I said each of the three boxes were worth \$20. USPS said, "so you're spending \$400 to ship something that's worth \$60 total. Geesh. I've been in contact with Mike. Our options are to unpack the boxes, give him the exact contents and see what he actually wants and needs, or wait till this Covid thing calms down and meet him at the border or Buffalo.
