Yes, I have read this document many times. Unfortunately, the step that says "6. Install the PARIS application" doesn't mention anything about an error even running the installer file.

The only thing I can find on Microsoft's site about the error is from Windows2000.

I think my version of XP has some sort of security update or something that is preventing the paris installer application from running.

I think it's Windows... grr.

If it was a clean install it might work. I am just not willing to start over on this machine. It would take too much time. The best thing for me to do I think is just copy all the paris projects off this machine and put them on CD's or something for my 98SE machine that is running Paris just fine.
