Good luck getting UADs and a TC to work in an expansion chassis.

My advice would be to swap you UAD PCI cards to PCI-e ones and use a PCI-e to PCI-e expansion chassis.

Which versions of the Powercore? The old pre- mk2 ones? If so you are best off getting one PCI or PCI-e mk2 one to replace those 2. The old will not work on newer hardware.

I've used the Cyclone chassis a few times with UADs and it worked great.

Otherwise I would go for the SBS chassis.
