\$75.00I've been trying to figure out what to do with my Paris DAW. This has been an extremely stable platform for me for many years. It is an ASUS A7V8X mobo. I have been running Paris on this since I built it in 2003. It has 2 NVidia 5500 video cards running in the AGP and mobo slot 2. I was running 4 x EDS cards in slots 1, 3, 4 and 5. It is loaded with 1 G PC2700 Corsair XMS RAM. the CPU is an AMD XP 2800 and the system drive is running Win ME and has been tweaked to be able to access 1 G RAM (a tweak that Rick shwoed me). I just figure this mobo would probably do someone here more good running Paris than it would being an office machine. This system will run a good number of VST plugins. I have never maxed it out, though that was a few years back before I started using UAD-1's pretty much exclusively.

I'll sell the mobo, 2 x video cards, RAM and system drive for \$200.00. If you use this system drive in it's current configuration, you *will* have a stable Paris system running Win ME (so you can use multiple ADAT cards in multiple MECs) and you *will* be able to use 4 x monitors.
