I don't often post here on the site, but i enjoy reading all the ideas you guys offer. I was reading some old post, trying to catch up to the new ones. Someone had a question about using two mecs and getting the sample rate light to match on both mecs at either 44 or 48. I know both mecs will record at the sample rate of the master mec, but it is nice to see those lights on both mecs reading the same.

- 1. Set your desired sample rate at either 44 or 48 in your project window
- 2. Click your sync source and change from internal to digital. The lights will blink on and off 2 or 3 time and the second mec should sync with the master mec.
- 3. Once the sample rate changes, switch back to internal and wait for the lights to stop blinking and you're set.

Hey! It works on my system. I didn't know if you guys new this or not. Just tring to be helpful. Let me know if it works for you, if you even care to try it.
