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The 38w box will not work - EDS cards are power hungry and four of them will want at least ten times that as a minimum for stable operation, preferably more. You definitely want to go with your own ATX case and a very robust power supply.

When you put it in your basket, just choose the connector type (express card 34, pcie or both). So in your case just choose express card 34.

The cable going from the chassis to the connector does indeed have the same ends as a dvi video card (so you have to be careful not to accidentally plug it into your video card or plug your monitor into it for those who get the pcie connector..).
