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Dear Ron,

First use the FREE Spinaudio demo wrapper.
This is the free version which lets you wrap only ONE instance of VST plugin.
You only need that here.
Wrap from spinaudio the chainer !
Now you can rename this as AA_Chainer! do this to have it first in my VST LIST.
Now from inside Chainer all UAD1 plugins are showing their meters.
Don't forget inside chainer to put FIRST the input module to have sound !!
The nice thing with chainer is that it has 10 pages meaning you can use 10 instances of UAD1 plugins without any additional latency !!
Spinaudio lowers the latency to 4096 samples instead of 16384 which chainer alone has as well as FXpansion too.

Other solution FREE and good is the FFX4 free VST?DX wrapper.
I have posted before all these I saying here with URL to download all this stuff.
From inside FFX-4 you can have your UAD1 plugins too.
I think metering works this too...
Will have to check.
