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My memory is a bit foggy, as I remember it, it was first shown at the January NAMM show 1997. S.C.S was there doing the demo along with others from Ensoniq.

I remember looking at the 442 and telling them that the standard was 8 in and 8 out on all audio interfaces that were coming out at that time. I thought the system was cool, but the 4 I/O wouldn't cut it, because Adats, DA 88s and 8 Bus boards were 8 ch., and the standard. It seemed like it took a year before the MEC were available.

At the show they were giving out free MIDI spiders. It was a rubber spider on the end of a MIDI cable, its eyes would light up to test your MIDI ports for signal, I still have some new in the package.
