I've done M-S for overheads with 2 condensers (Microtech Gefell umt70s), and with 2 ribbons (Beyer m130 and m160), but not both types together in M-S. It might be an interesting sound.

M-S buys you the ability to control your width and ambience after the fact, which can be really great. Plus, it's totally mono compatible (though you'd better make sure you like the sound of your M, because that's all you'll get in mono). You should make sure you can monitor a decoded stereo signal (try Voxengo's free plugin), but record only the M-S so you can change it later.

M-S can also sound great on piano... and lots of other things. You can also experiment using an omni mic for the M.
