You can use S1 to reverse channels and put all left or all right in both channels and with Stereo Analyzer you can see how much correlation there is between the left and right channels.

It's amazing how much stereo imagery you can get with stuff that's 98% correlated (example: moonlight feels right). The mix is pretty mono with rhodes left and vibes keyboard right. DOubled vocal in mono! Kewl stuff. Here's another one for your comments. Load the song up and tell me what you hear.
