I have been trying to learn my way around Nuendo as a possible future tracking/mixing app. One of the biggest advantages to me was its auto latency compensation, or so I thought. I was fooling around with stems of a song I recorded in Paris and I used a few plugins on some of the stems. I finished what little processing I was adding and started really listening to the song as a whole when I realized it didn't have the same "feel" as it did without any processing. I listened to the 2 track version and it definately sounded more "musical". After much muting and bypassing, I realized that the guitars and bass were a little late and it was ruining the rhythm of the song.

I agree that the tracks would have been way out of sync without the latency compensation, but it didn't correct properly. How can I trust it now?

Anyone else have this issue?
