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I'm doing a 36 track mix in Cubase SX right now with 8 x stereo stems routed to Paris submix 1. Very stable. Sounding better and better as I go. I feel sorta' like I just stepped in poo, but as I get the hang of it I'm thinking I just might be able to achieve something *very nice*.
Neil/Martin/LaMont/Dedric..et al, are correct about the mix bus being much improved these days. It's just a different journey to get there.

I'd *really* like to get this thing happening with Forte but unless we can get enough folks together to justify it for the developer, We're getting close to finishing some tracking on a project here and the mixes are coming up pretty soon so it's getting to be close to time to take off the lab coat, put Igor back in the dungeon and think in terms of getting these up and ready to go.

I've thought through using 3 x computers running Forte. I would need to get another Multiface and another UAD-1 to get this happening the way I need to and the thought of simultaneously digitally bussing multiple outboard FX processors through three computers is making me sorta queasy. Without each interface receiving a BNC feed directly off the house clock (which they can't do), this is a trainwreck in the making and then I'm back to square 1. I would have to do this in order to accomplish the aux routing across submixes that I would want to do and I'm already fried just thinking about this one.
