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The sync generated from the Paris ADAT will be the same as the Sync provided by the Apogee Big Ben as long as Paris is slaved to the Big Ben. Just use a 9 pin sync cable from the paris ADAT module to the ADAT sync port on the RME card. I'm syncing x RME HDSDP cards this way.,
