That is NOT the situation with vertex which is a real compensator !
You have to put the latency ONLY on the track you are putting a UAD1 plug
like in track 1.
the rest audio tracks get aligned AUTOMATICALLY !!
And Deej note that you can compensate for EDS effctcs too which uad1 compensator
cannot do that...
That to take the clouds off of Vertex.
