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Pete, Now that you got that solved. Hide the default ppj in another folder besides the root EMU folder. This will force Paris to open from an internal default, not your set up default.

Now remove all but 1 eds and when Paris opens, it will only have 1 eds submix. Now install the EMU card and see if that works. Then you will know if you need sp2 or not. If it works, start adding ade cards, 1 at a time, then the UAD card till everything works. Take it one step at a time, control the variables.
