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Define 'link'.. if you mean, will it follow paris MTC sync from one machine to another, yes it will. I've never tried to do the OMF thing between them.

Also, you'll have to stripwav anything coming from sonar to Paris (

<http://www.lightlink.com/tjweber/StripWav/StripWav.html>) and avoid using sample rates Paris won't play back - stick to 44.1 for best results.
