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In order to insert external hardware on a playback track, you have to connect the input of the external device to a physical output on the 442, MEC or output modules. The output of the external device is then patched to a matching input on the same 442, MEC etc to complete the loop. In the Paris patchbay, you make the software connection for the insert point. The track insert EDS effect "External" would also need to be selected to make this work.
