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Hi Dan,

The PC should definitely not be freezing when loading PARIS 2.1. The version of the driver that I posted a screen shot of earlier is the first version of the ASIO driver. It supported a 64 bit Windows, but only a 32 bit ASIO host. There was a lot of work to do porting the user mode part of the PARIS driver to 64 bits. The second version came out in 2019 (I believe), and supports both 32 bit and 64 bot ASIO hosts, as well as a 32 sample buffer size. The change to allow 32 sample buffers required altering the firmware that runs on the EDS cards.

The order of install matters for the ASIO driver. The ASIO installer must be run after the non-ASIO driver installer, as it updates components. If the older installer that includes the PARIS software is run after the ASIO driver is installed, it can replace files and create a mis-match between the kernel and user mode drivers.

Let me know if you'd like me to take a look over TeamViewer. The machine definitely should not be freezing.
