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There are balanced line I/O on the back of the unit. They are XLR. This unit is one of the true sleepers. Used to cost around \$1k. Can be had cheap these days (around \$350.00) on EBay. It's got a nice vibe to it. I like the preamp on acoustic guitar and it works nicely on the Neumann U87 for some reason. It somehow deals nicely with the midrange honk of this mic in a way that more expensive preamps don't. I think it's because of the elves.
