I can boot paris (v3) no problem, but if I have the MEC switched on, I get Error 2/2 when it tries to initialize the hardware. Then Paris just shuts down again. I've stripped everything out of my MEC, but its still the same.

My PC is a 'fresh' install of ME with only the Paris software on it (it's also the same PC I ran paris on years ago, so I know the spec is ok)

anybody tell me what the error means? I'm thinking faulty cable or faulty MEC (aaargh!)
