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Sometimes PARIS gets confused about the audio files used to represent its virtual submixes.

- hit "A" to call up the Audio Bin and delete all submix files (they're the "greyed out" files)
- make a new folder
- go back into PARIS and change your record path to that folder
- save your song
- hit "recalculate all submixes"
- (if you have multiple virtual submixes) grab a coffee.
