I don't know about BFD, but Toontracks has some DFH Superior demo videos on their web site with a drummer playing a Roland TD-20 kit with some extra eCymbals and the latency is very low. The performances are killer! I think they have pretty detailed instructions on how to set it up also. Here's a link:
