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Globals are in PARIS\_FX.VAR. If you have them in the projects you can load  
the project and move them to globals.

LIBRARY presets are saved in the PARIS\_FX.VAR file  
in C:\Program Files\Paris3 (your Paris root dir).

PARIS\_Fx.var (Default) is a backup of the file  
PARIS\_Fx.var that gets modified when you make library presets.

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Your global effects were in PARIS\_FX.VAR. If you overwrote this file without backing them up they are gone. If you have them in project files and not in global effects you can then just add them back into global by opening one project at a time and pushing them into the global area. Then backup the file PARIS\_FX.VAR.

The default is just a backup of the original paris presets before we add any.
