that allows you to assign any driver on your system to a specific CPU. If you set the paris driver to one cpu and set the Paris application to the same CPU using the THG Task Assignment Manager, you can run Paris on any CPU in your system without having C16 lockups. This will be awesome when I can finally upgrade to a quad core. Yeeeeeehaw!!!
