They were competing with Pro Tools, went through the Ensoniq collapse, reprised shortly thereafter by the Emu collapse, were trying to sell a DSP system just as their target market--high end home studio to very nice professional studio--was discovering how good native apps could be, and finally SSC's health problems. A lot of people would have stopped throwing the dice long before ID did after getting snake eyes that many times in a row.
