Install UAD to it's default location (program files / universal Audio))

Install waves to their default location (program files / Waves)

Now I also have a Steinberg folder that has a VXT folder and that's where I put the faderworks  
folder and installed faderworks within that folder

Also inside the Steinberg VST folder is a Powered Plugin folder and that's where I C&P the  
fxpansion "fxvdx30.dll"
