Bill,

I'm getting real happy with this one. The Pultec is one of my essentials around here just because it has such an organic vibe to it. the Neve has this same thing going on, but it's a lot more flexible. I've got a song mix happening right now with 18 x UAD-1 plugins instantiated, 13 of which are pretty CPU intensive. I've got a Pultec, Multiband and 1176 on the bass bus, Pultecs and 1176's on both beater and shell kick tracks, 1176's on a pair of toms, Neves and 1176's on top and bottom snare, LA-2A on vocal and Neves on 4 acoustic guitar tracks.. The UAD-1 resource usage is around 56% on 4 x UAD-1 cards.
